## THE VISION:

To create an annual event called a Caribbean Prayer Summit where the spiritual leaders and intercessors within the Caribbean nations are called together to address the troubling issues of the region. To see success in CARICOM as they tackle trade relations and troubling issues facing the region.

### Why A Summit?

As Christians we need to get together to address territorial spirits which have been strongholds within particular nations. These spirits although, being addressed locally in many nations, seem to be immovable. The Scripture states that one can chase a thousand but two puts ten thousand to flight. (Psalm 68:35). A corporate anointing in united prayer we believe will better be able to dislodge these strongholds.

Apart from nations being prayed for, individual prayer leaders can be strengthened to return to continue in the building of intercessory work within their nation – upholding their national and religious leaders; strengthening the children and youth to pray and watch God use them as world-changers and agents of transformation.

## MISSION:

To provide a forum where the following goals and objectives may be realized:-

- To spiritually lead the way for CARICOM so that our Governments will be able to accomplish their goals for the welfare of the region.
- To provide a forum for the networking of Intercessory Prayer leaders across the Caribbean – no island/nation is to stand alone in its spiritual war.
- Strategic planning for the setting up of a national prayer network on islands/ nations where there might not be any in place – every island needs one.
- To provide a forum for forgiveness of any atrocities that might have been done between the nations and Reconciliation between the Caribbean nations and with their “mother countries”.
- To strengthen and empower prayer leaders to return to their nations/islands and seek to multiply prayer groups and fellowships – partnership and identification with others with similar vision and burdens is an encouragement to Kingdom advancement
- Development of links, networks, and initiatives in the region; exposing what already exists.
- To encourage the Caribbean youth and children to become more involved in intercession – raising up Millennials to be powerful and effective in prayer.
- To present the concept of a National/Regional Day of Prayer and have it initiated in all the nations.

## THE BEGINNINGS

The sojourn started when the International Prayer Council asked Maria Harbajan, a Jamaican, to assist them in networking prayer leaders, movements and initiatives in the Caribbean. The concept of the staging of a Caribbean Prayer Summit (CPS) was one of the avenues to facilitate this process.



Why a Summit and not a Conference? A Summit allows for the practical sharing and working out of strategies as meet in order to carry out the purpose and objectives of the CPS. The nation chosen to launch this event in May 2007 was Barbados. At the end of this Summit, the delegates in looking at the Way Forward decided on the planning of another Caribbean Prayer Summit and making the event an annual one, moving it around the region.
